Medicolegal Experience:

I am preparing medical reports from 2007.

I have attended court twice to provide expert evidence and once to GMC MFTP Panel hearing to provide expert evidence.

A fee for medical report is due in advance or within 30 days following submission of invoice. Commissioning Solicitor is responsible for fee. For the avoidance of doubt, Dr Sharma is instructed as principal and not as an agent for your client.

Exceptionally large bundles may require longer time to prepare report and will cost more. Usual fee for report is around £1800-2000 plus VAT. Clinical Negligence reports cost around £2000-2500 plus VAT. Desktop reports cost around £1000 plus VAT.
